# -Class DIVISIONS-

All Courses are set on a 12' stride

**LUNGE LINE W/T**-Open to riders who do not ride independently; equitation tests are limited to rising & sitting trot and demonstration of 2-point (jumping) position. Cannot enter any other division.

**PRE-BEGINNER W/T 1 @ a TIME**-Open to riders who do not ride in groups; equitation tests are limited to rising & sitting trot and demonstration of 2-point position. Cannot enter any other division.

**BEGINNER W/T**- Open to riders who do not canter in groups; equitation tests limited to rising & sitting trot and demonstration of 2-point position. May only cross enter into the Beginner Poles division.

**BEGINNER POLES**-Open to riders who do not canter in groups or jump. Riders will perform a trot course over poles (1@ a time). Suitability of mount to count. May only cross enter into the Beginner W/T division.

**CROSS RAIL HUNTER**-Open to beginner riders who have not shown over 18"; fence height is 12". Course is cross rails with simple flower boxes. Suitability of mount to count; riders will not be penalized for trotting on course. May only cross enter into Green Hunter Division.

**GREEN HUNTER**-Open to all horses or riders not ready for the hunter ring. Course consists of six cross rails or vertical jumps at 18" with one change of direction. Riders will not be penalized for trotting on course or simple lead changes. May cross enter into Cross Rail Hunter if rider is eligible.

**SCHOOLING HUNTER**- Open to all horses & riders. Jumps 2' or 2'6".

**SHORT/LONG STIRRUP**: Open to junior & amateur riders in their first two years of showing higher than 18"; may cross into Schooling hunter.

**GREEN HORSE W/T**- Open to green horses not ready to canter in groups; horse cannot have shown in any HUS, Pleasure class, or Eq on the flat at any show in which horses cantered in a group.

**HORSEMANSHIP**-Open to all riders. A written test to evaluate the rider's general knowledge of horses and care. Two level of testing available (beginner & intermediate); top three riders will be asked to demonstrate skills on horse. Prizes are specialty ribbons in 1<sup>st</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> place and an additional prize for first.

*The schedule is subject to change at the discretion of Management*

## Springtime Schooling Show General Rules and Information:

- Any act of discourtesy to a judge, show official or staff member on the part of any trainer, owner, rider or groom will immediately disqualify any horse which they are associated with and all entry fees will be forfeited.
- Horses and ponies may enter no more than seven over fences classes at any one show, including equitation & special classes.
- Management may combine or divide classes as warranted by entries.
- Hard hats must be worn by all mounted riders at all times. **All riders must wear ASTM-SEI Approved Helmets with a properly-adjusted (snug) harness.**
- The class schedule is subject to change at the discretion of Show Management.
- Hunter courses shall simulate obstacles found in the hunt field such as natural rails, gates, walls, etc.
- Champion and Reserve will be awarded in all divisions except Lunge Line. To be eligible, a rider must participate in all three classes of the division & a minimum of three riders is required to fill in the division.
- No dogs are allowed on the premises.**
- Management reserves the right to limit entries to ensure a safe show environment.
- All horses will be required to show proof of negative Coggins to be on grounds.

Back numbers will not be released without payment *and* signatures on **all three lines** of the entry form.
